5 Day South Australia and Kangaroo Island Adventure!

Day One

A big welcome to the students on arrival in Adelaide. We will head straight to the West Beach Caravan Park and get settled in. After lunch we will drive to Morialta Falls, at the base of the Adelaide Hills. Students will walk up to Castle Rock and be met with a superb view over Adelaide. Dinner will be back at West Beach, and weather permitting, we will play beach cricket and night games!

Day Two

This morning we have an early start to ensure we are on the ferry at 9am. The Sealink Ferry to Kangaroo Island takes a little over 40 minutes and is an adventure in itself! Once on the Island we will drive for a short time before stopping for a climb to the top of Prospect Hill, where students will get a birds eye view of the Island. We will also explore Pennington Bay before departing for Bales Beach where we will have lunch. After lunch we will join a guide for a tour at Seal Bay. Here Australian sea lions and fur seals can be seen in their natural environment. In the afternoon we will drive up to Snug Cove - a magnificent property on the north coast. We will set up camp before heading to the cove to explore the rock pools before dinner.



Day Three

An exciting morning this morning as we head south to the Kelly Hill Caves. Students will wear helmets and head torches, and climb down to experience adventure caving! Flinders Chase National Park is our destination for the afternoon. Flinders Chase National Park offers magnificent wildlife viewing opportunities as well as the historic Cape de Couedic lighthouse, Admirals Arch, and Remarkable Rocks. Tonight we'll enjoy some songs and stories around the campfire.



Day Four

Snug Cove is perfect for snorkelling - weather permitting, this is one activity we will do in the morning. Students will also do a cliff walk - the views from the top are incredible. We'll try our luck at catching marron in the marron ponds before we have lunch, and then depart Snug Cove and head to the Parndana Wildlife Park. Here students can have their photos taken with koalas, they can feed the kangaroos, and see an abundance of native bird life. The Penneshaw Hotel provides a great dinner before jumping on the ferry back to the mainland. Tonight we'll stay at the Victor Harbor campground.



Day Five

This morning we will go over to Granite Island on the Horse tram. Students will have the opportunity to see fairy penguins and see one of Adelaide's favourite seaside towns. We will have lunch at the local bakery before departing for the Adelaide Airport.

This itinerary depends on flight arrival and departure times.
