# Environmental Study Program



### Example Six Days in Perth Region, Western Australia

This is an example of one of many programs that can be supplied in a number of venues throughout Australia. Programs and length of stay can be tailored to suit the requirements of each group.

**English language** lessons can be provided as specific lessons within the program as well as an informal part of many activities.

**Requirements and Equipment:** There are no special student requirements; all programs are suitable for a wide range of fitness and age levels and all necessary equipment is provided.

**This program focuses upon:** environmental interpretation, interactions with native fauna, working in teams, personal challenge and having fun together! Activities and lessons conducted by accredited, experienced instructors. Includes all transport, camping, hiking, catering and activity equipment.

<b>One</b>	AM – Travel from overseas (ETA 1400) PM – Transfer (1 hr) to commencement of Expedition. Commence Bibbulmun Track expedition to first campsite (max 2 hrs). Evening – Instructor introduction, program orientation & outdoors skills sessions.	Refer Bibbulmun Track site Expedition in two groups of approx. 15 students. Presentation & discussion re program journal (30 pages, supplied)  <b>Overnight tent camp</b>
<b>Two</b>	AM/PM – Continue expedition (18 kms) EV – “Starry, starry night”  <b>Overnight tent camp</b>	1. Formal explorations of the natural forest environment en route. 2. Activities promoting social interaction, group cohesion & group living skills. 3. Outdoors skills. 4. Evening stargazing.
<b>Three</b>	AM/PM – Conclude expedition. Mountain Bike introduction, skills course & trail ride EV – Introduction to climbing Gymnasium	AM – Establish skills base PM – Ride the Katta Moorda trail EV – expert tuition  <b>Lodge accommodation</b>
<b>Four</b>	AM – Kayak orientation & paddle in the Caning River Regional Park. PM – Adventure World EV – Bar-b-que meal at Harry Waring Nature Reserve. “Snakes Alive!”	AM – View Ibis, Spoonbills, etc PM – Shaded, river-side venue EV – Interact with evening animals (kangaroos, bandicoots, possums) plus an interaction with some Australian reptiles.  <b>Lodge accommodation</b>
<b>Five</b>	AM – Sea kayak paddle in the Shoalwater Islands National Park. PM – Explore Fremantle precinct EV – Spit roast meal in Kings Park overlooking Perth city.	AM – includes penguin viewing & interpretive centre, “enviroquest” natural history treasure hunt, view sea lions from the kayaks. PM –Historical focus.  <b>Lodge accommodation</b>
<b>Six</b>	AM – Shopping (2 hrs), transfer to Caversham Wildlife Park for escorted tour & lunch. PM – Depart for home	AM – Finale includes presentation of certificates & Environmental Encounters shirts, conclude program journals.

- All locations are near Perth. Minimal coach travel involved. Maximum activity time.
